THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WERE DECIDED AT OUR AGM AND WILL BE PUT IN PLACE FOR THE 2010/2011 SEASON:

- It was approved to move the Chestermere Men's Bonspiel from February to November.
- It was approved to apply 4 foot lines to sheets #1 and #3 only.
- It was approved to apply the outline of a set of rings on the center of Sheet #4 to aid the Junior Curling Program.
- It was approved to continue with an A and a B division on the Wednesday Mixed League ONLY.
- It was approved to offer our Men's and Ladies **Aggregate** Winners the opportunity to participate in the Dominion Curling Championships and to offer the Men's and Ladies Playoff **League** Winners the opportunity to participate in the City Club Managers Championships. The Mixed and Open leagues will still send the **Aggregate** Winners to the City Club Managers Championships. If any of these teams are unable to attend then the 2nd place finishers in the perspective pools will be extended the offer to attend.
