#### **New Business**

### 1) CRCA

There will continue to be 3 Sheets of ice as per last year. The end boards were put in for lacrosse so had to be removed for the 2018-2019 curling year. Short bolts were put in so ice will need to be thicker to accommodate removal without replacement of the metal plates holding the bolts. Brian Nociar reported on how this will affect curling in the upcoming year. As a result ice making and ice conditions will be challenging. Concerns were also expressed regarding the extra load it will place on the compressor in order maintain ice temperature, and there is potential risk of a failure as a result. Discussion occurred regarding the concerns as a result of this approach. Nick will e-mail Jody and Mike regarding expressed concerns to see if there is a possibility of removing the bolt plates for the curling season, as they said they would reconsider if this created problems for curling.

- 2) Practice Curling begins Saturday September 29 from 1:00 to 3:00 PM- this may need to be adjusted based on the ice-making challenges
- **3)** Curling Clinic Sunday September 30 from 1 to 4 pm –is being held for Beginners and Refreshers The first 24 people who sign up will be accommodated.

Dates may also need to be changed based on when the ice gets in.

- 4) Exhibition Games are the week of October 1<sup>st</sup> for all leagues
- 5) Mixed Bonspiel will be held as a Joint effort with Indus again this year January 25, 26, 27 2019 There will be no ladies or men's bonspiel again this year.
- 6) Discussion occurred regarding consideration of incorporating the 5-guard rule. It is not required for our league level. Championship games outside of our league may include it. Motion: Bob Johnson moved we move to adopt the 5 rock rule Second: Wolfgang Janke Carried
- 7) Casino- We have no casino this year We should receive information on the upcoming casino in the fall of 2019

### 8) CCRRB Grant

We received \$1230 which we can apply towards 50% of the cost of: New scraper blade, sticky mats, carpets for the concession area, vacuum Mike has bought sticky mats for every user including schools. Carpets have been purchased for the waiting area. A vacuum also has been purchased.

**9) SACA Grant:** Nick applied to SACA and we received a grant to replace our nipper to purchase an alarm for the ice plant in case there is a malfunction. We will need to provide receipts to SACA. It was suggested we buy a reconditioned nipper due to current financial constraints.

10) Ice Preparation- They will be painting and putting in the ice surface the weekend of September  $22^{nd}$  and September  $23^{rd}$ . Those interested in assisting the Nociars' can contact them. The Nociar's requested assistance in pebbling the ice after the games so they are prepared if the schools come in the following morning.
